Good evening, Finn Families-

As a reminder, we welcome scholars tomorrow, Monday, March 16th, and beginning Tuesday, March 17th Finn will be closed through Monday, April 13th. While we hope to see all scholars tomorrow, we also understand that some parents/guardians may choose to keep their scholars home for various reasons. For any scholars not in attendance tomorrow, we will be facilitating a pick-up time from 3:30-5:00 for families to pick up the optional learning materials that will be handed out during the day. We will have an additional pick-up window from 8:30-10:00 am on Tuesday morning; both pick-up locations will be at the main William Street entrance (under the pavilion).

Throughout the closure, it will be a priority for us to ensure that our scholars have access to breakfast and lunch. Below, please find important information pertaining to meal pick-up, which will provide food for two days of breakfast and lunch.

- Monday, March 16th: tables will be set up near the main William Street exit and families may come and pick up food items for Tuesday. Our scholars who ride the bus will have the opportunity to get items prior to dismissal, if they choose. For scholars not in attendance, food items can be picked up during the 3:30-5:00 learning material pick-up window.
- Wednesday, March 18th and Friday, March 20th will be pick-up days from 8:00-11:00 am
- Monday, March 23 through Friday, April 3, food items will be available for pick-up every Monday, Wednesday and Friday from 8:00-11:00 am. Please note that we will not be doing food pick-up during the scheduled spring break (April 6-13), but can provide additional food items to families in need on the April 3rd pick-up date.

Additional information will be sent home tomorrow with scholars from grade level teachers, and an additional school-wide email.
