**Letter to Parents for School Meal Programs  
Special Provision Options (Provision 2 Non-Base Year & Community Eligibility Provision)**

Dear Parent or Guardian:

We are pleased to inform you that Finn Academy: An Elmira Charter School will be continuing participation in CEP, a meal certification option available to schools participating in the National School Lunch and School Breakfast Programs for 2020-2021.

**What does this mean for your child(ren) attending Finn Academy?**

All students enrolled at Finn Academy are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school at **no charge** to your household each day of the 2020-21 school year. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or have money on account for these two meals. This applies to all remote meals during emergency feeding situations such as the current pandemic.
